## *RESULTS of SURVEYS*

Results of the Ad Hoc KAPPAN Committee's survey and the Ad Hoc Resolution #2 Survey on Virtual Attendance at Chapter Meetings are attached in the email with this newsletter. They will continue to explore options and will report to the International Executive Board and International Chapter at their next meetings in May, 2020. ### ***Kaleidoscope? What is Kaleidoscope??***

Alpha Delta Kappa has moved to all online scholarship and grant applications for the rest of the biennium. The International Executive Board has adopted the use of Kaleidoscope, a secure online platform which manages the scholarship and grant application process from beginning (initial applications) to end (adjudication and reports provided to the appropriate chairmen); this change will ultimately speed up the process and allow us to put awarded funds in the hands of recipients in a more timely fashion. As with anything new, there is certainly a learning curve. International Executive Board Liaison to all Scholarships and Grants Committees Ann Marie Brown has been working with Kaleidoscope to make the transition as smooth as possible, but it will take time for us all to become accustomed to the new procedures.
