Bylaws Biennial Report

2020-2022

At the Alpha Delta Kappa Delaware state convention, April 12, 2014, members unanimously voted to suspend the Delaware Alpha Delta Kappa Bylaws for they (1) mirror the bylaws of our international organization, and (2) follow the Delaware Alpha Delta Kappa Policies and Procedures manual that was in place and complied with the International Constitution and Bylaws.

During this biennium, our official policy statement was sent to the International Bylaws Chairman to be reviewed for certification. That statement was reviewed and was certified.

Since that time, the state bylaws committee has revised our Delaware Policies and Procedures Manual. The latest revision is available on the Delaware Alpha Delta Kappa website. We thank all those who helped in the process of keeping our manual up-to-date. We will continue to make any changes as they become necessary.

The official Policy Statement of our Policies and Procedures manual will be updated following the installation of our 2022-2024 officers.


At this time, The Delaware Alpha Delta Kappa Bylaws Committee recommends the following:

1. That each chapter submit to the state bylaws chairman, for certification, a current copy of the policy statement from the chapter's policies and procedures manual by March 15, 2023; and
2. That an electronically signed copy of the revised Official Statement of the Delaware Policies and Procedures manual for the 2022-2024 biennium be sent to Mary Lou Beck, International Bylaws Chairman 2021-2023, for certification by October 15, 2022; and
3. That revisions to the Delaware Policies and Procedures manual continue to occur as needed to reflect changes to the International Bylaws and the work of the Delaware Executive Board.
