It has been a privilege to be the Alpha Delta Kappa Delaware World Understanding Chairperson for this biennium.

During the biennium, our international chapter did not select a project since the three chosen did not qualify. Members were encouraged to donate to previous projects.

The Delaware chapters held truly diverse activities devoted to World Understanding. Chapters read books to broaden their world view, hosted Delaware's ITE Scholar from South Africa , Thembisile Buthelezi, who shared her culture and how she is adjusting to her stay in the United States, reviewed ADK International News in the KAPPAN to find out what's happening around the world, and watched webinars about the ITE Scholars.

Recommendations:

1. Ask Chapter presidents to send names of World Understanding chapter chairs to State Chair as soon as they are appointed .
2. Have the State World Understanding chair to check in periodically with chapter chairs to offer assistance or suggest ideas.
3. Have the World Understanding Chair help chapters better distinguish between Altruistic projects and World Understanding activities.
