Goal 1: Refine Governance and Communication Outcome: Increase efficiency and effectiveness in governance, communication, finances and infrastructure in Alpha Delta Kappa.*

Improve Communication

By May 2026, DE AΔK will improve communication by highlighting at least one chapter's altruistic activity or world understanding activity in each issue of the State Newsletter.

Goal 2: Enhance Educational, Professional and Leadership Development. Outcome: Offer educational, professional and leadership programs that cultivate and support members from chapter to international levels.*

Identify, recruit and train leaders that encourage diverse participation.

By May 2026, DE AΔK will incorporate leadership development by encouraging sisters to take advantage of grants and scholarships at each state meeting and will have one application submitted for at least one grant and one scholarship per year in the biennium.

Goal 3. Promote Benefits of AΔK and Increase Membership Outcome: Assist S/P/N and chapter membership teams to recruit, reinstate, retain, and revitalize membership, and establish new chapters and collegiate clubs; net growth of 1% each biennium.

Nurture members through S/P/N programs, activities, service opportunities and participation beyond the chapter level.

By May 2026, DE AΔK will promote ideas and activities for improving and maintaining membership through visitation of all chapters by the 4P's to review membership objectives and activities will be tracked through chapter minutes.

Goal 4. Promote Altruism, Scholarships and World Understanding Initiatives. Outcome: Enrich the lives of others through altruism, service, scholarships, grants, and world understanding.* Encourage participation in project at the chapter, S/P/N, regional, and international level.

By May 2026, DE AΔK will encourage chapters to develop at least one world understanding activity that will be shared at state meetings and tracked through the state minutes and/or highlighted in an issue of the state newsletter/website.
